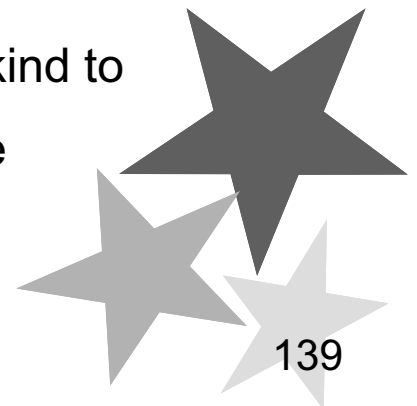

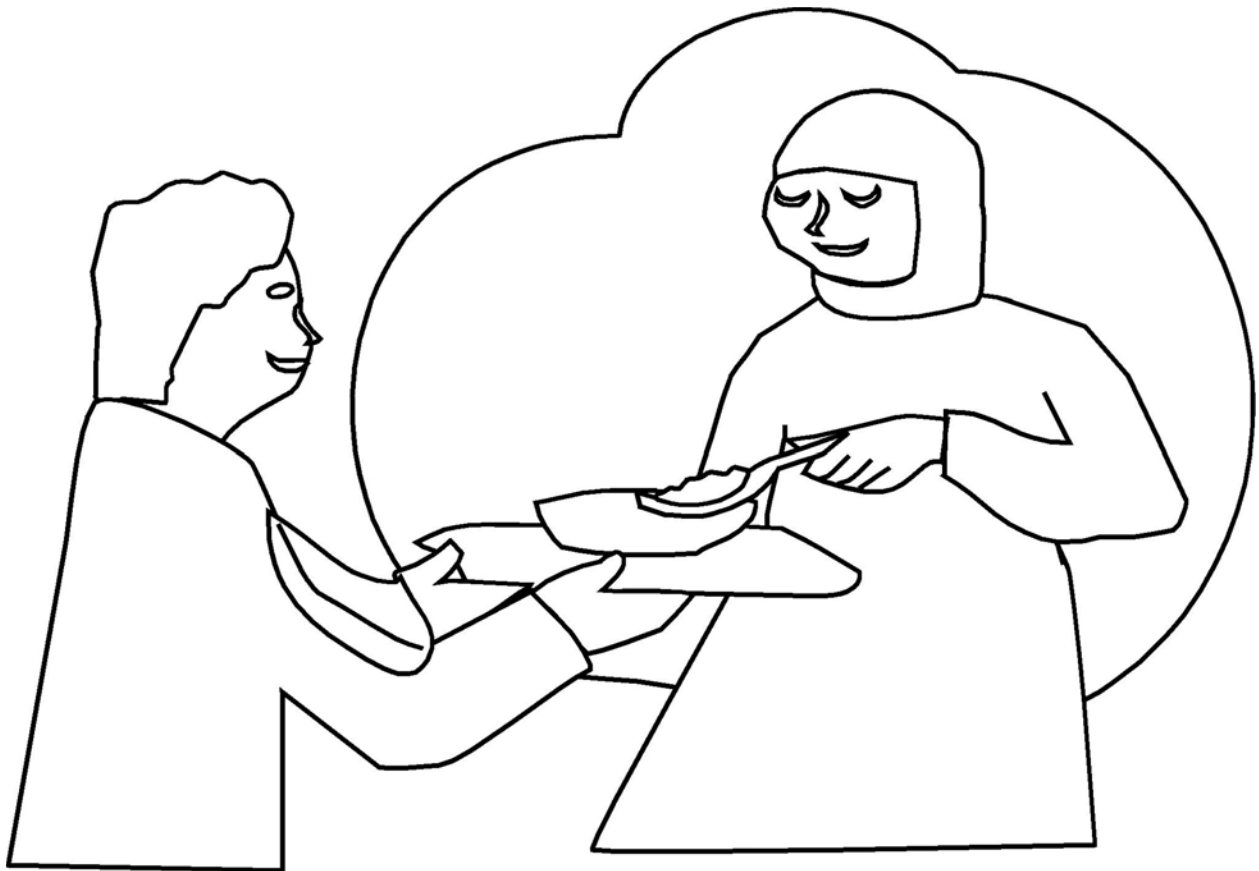


in need.

Remember!

- We worship Allah ﷻ by praying, fasting, giving zakat, and performing Hajj.
- We also worship Allah by reading Quran, struggling for the cause of Allah ﷻ and doing good deeds such as being kind to others, helping the poor and those in need.
- The Prophet ﷺ prayed 10 ruka'a at night, called Qiyam.
- After Qiyam, the Prophet ﷺ ended his prayers with 3 ruka'as, 2 called Ashafi' and one called Alwitr.
- Qiyam, Ashafi' and Alwitr prayers are sunna prayers which Muslims do to get closer to Allah ﷻ and are not Fardh like the regular 5 daily prayers.
