



## Ibadat Game: Sunna (Nawafil) Prayers

- Some of the Muslims did not obey the instructions of the Prophet ﷺ and left their places during the battle. This allowed the pagans to attack Muslims and kill many of them.
- Muslims prevented the pagans from entering Medina during the battle of the ditch by digging a ditch around the parts of Medina not protected by mountains.

## **Ibadat Game: Hajj - Part II**


